

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF THE
SIERRA CHRISTIAN SERVICE CAMP

Know all men by these presents:

I

That the Sierra Christian Service Camp, an unincorporated association, is the name of the organization, which is being incorporated.

II

That the name of this Corporation is and shall be SIERRA CHRISTIAN SERVICE CAMP.

III

That the Corporation is organized pursuant to the general non-profit corporation law, or pursuant to Part 1 of Division 2 of Title of the Corporation Code.

IV

That the principal office shall be in the County of Tulare, State of California.

V

That this Corporation is formed for benevolent, educational, recreational and evangelistic purposes, and especially:

- (1) To uphold the standard of the Church of Christ as revealed in the New Testament scriptures; To contend for the inspiration of the the Scriptures, and for the Deity of Christ, (which includes) The Virgin Birth, The Blood Atonement, His Bodily Resurrection from the Grave, His Ascension into Heaven, and His personal coming again; to teach the plan of salvation as recorded in the New Testament, (which includes) God's Grace, Man's Faith, Repentance, Confession, Baptism and Godly Living; to contend for the Scriptural Ideal of the Church, in Life, Teaching, Names, Organization and purpose.
- (2) to operate a camp for the principal purpose of training people in the ways of the gospel and for the preaching of that gospel and for the preaching of that gospel in all nations to establish Churches of Christ after the New Testament order.
- (3) To purchase and own real estate and other property as may be necessary to carry out the object and purpose of said Sierra Christian service Camp.
- (4) To have full and complete power to acquire or receive by gift, grant, annuity, purchase, devise, bequest, or in any other manner, property of every kind and character, and to hold, use, sell, lease, mortgage, or hypothecate, or otherwise dispose of, or use, the same for above mentioned purposes.

VI

That this Corporation is not an auxiliary of, or subordinated to, any district, state, or national board, or any other form of ecclesiastical system, or any other corporation or association; but is free and independent in all of it's transactions.

VII

That this corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to any of its members.

VIII

That no person shall ever be elected, or allowed to serve, as a teacher, director or trustee, who is not in accord with the Policy and doctrinal position of the Sierra Christian Service camp.

IX

That the term during which said Corporation shall exist is forever and continuously.

X

That there is no capital stock nor shares of stock.

XI

That the number of trustees shall be seven (7). The trustees shall be elected from the Board of Directors and the number to remain the same unless changed by amendment of the by-laws as the need may arise. The names and residences of the Trustees which are elected to serve for the first year are as follows, or until their successors are elected or appointed; (Names Omitted).

XII

That the by-laws of this Corporation shall be adopted by the trustees named in the Articles of Incorporation and may thereafter be amended or repealed in any manner provided in said by-laws.
